As REDS expands to include 8th grade by the 2028–2029 school year, this role will evolve to include teaching responsibilities for both 7th and 8th grade.

Responsibilities

- Develop and implement thematic units that build basic vocabulary and conversational skills
- Create opportunities for students to interact in limited social situations using Spanish
- Foster students' awareness and appreciation of the distinct cultures, traditions, and celebrations of the Spanish-speaking world
- Connect language learning to real-world applications that inspire students to become global citizens
- Assess student progress and provide meaningful feedback
- Collaborate with Middle School faculty to support the whole-child development of our students
- Participate in school community events as appropriate

- Bachelor's degree required; degree in Spanish, Education, or related field preferred
- Proficiency in the Spanish language
- Experience teaching middle school students preferred
- Passion for working with adolescents and creating an inclusive, supportive classroom environment
- Commitment to the Episcopal values that guide our school community
- Ability to inspire curiosity, creativity, and active inquiry in young learners
- Strong communication and organizational skills
